## Color differences in non-colored polyurethane articles

In the case of polyurethane materials without coloring (color additive), color differences may occur within a production series - due to manufacturing-related variations in the raw materials used (usually from yellow-translucent to white-translucent, or from whitish to yellowish to brownish). If uniform coloration is required in the application, coloring is essential. However, it should also be noted that color additives can slightly influence the technical properties. Most color additives neither meet the requirements for repeated food contact according to FDA (Regulation Reference 21CFR 178.3297) nor do they

comply with the requirements of the European Food Contact Systems EU Regulation 10/2011/EU and 1935/2004/EC. The only color approved for food contact is blue (see next page).

The perception of the color and color differences strongly depends on the existing light conditions and the environment (e.g. base on which the components are viewed) and may differ from the photos shown below. The photos are only intended to give an indication of possible color differences.

In order to maintain consistent color quality, we recommend ordering items from the polyurethane in one of our standard colors or according to your specific color request.

According to our raw material suppliers, the dye used meets the requirements of the European Food Contact Systems EU Regulation 10/2011/EU as well as 1935/2004/EC.
